Job Duties

- Performs and records regular behavioural assessments of new intakes, animals in the re-homing centre and any in foster care to promptly identify any behavioural welfare issues
- Designs behavioural modification plans for individual animals. Designs, implements, monitor and adjust dog training and socialisation programmes. Works closely with the Animal Care Manager to implement these plans.
- Weekly team meetings to identify and discuss any behaviour problems
- Regular management meetings regarding modification / training plans, dog integrations, adoptions and behavioural welfare issues
- Works with the Animal Care Manager to select, implement and monitor dog integrations
- Works with the Adoptions Coordinator to assess adopter suitability, provide behaviour updates for adopters, and provide post-adoption support should behaviour issues arise
- Monitors the behaviour and training of animals in foster care.
- Provides training for the centre team in fear free animal handling, animal communication dog training and socialisation. Training should be conveyed in an inspiring way for non English speaking staff also.

- Organised and self-motivated
- High level of English speaking
- Maturity, good judgement and professionalism at all times
- Good level of physical fitness and strength, be able to lift a 20kg dog and be prepared to walk in all sorts of weather.
