New volunteers must complete a one-month probation. To extend to a second month, the Animal Care Supervisors will discuss extensions, based on performance, on a case-by-case basis.

Where possible, volunteers are welcome to stay in the on-site rooms neighbouring our animals (though these are first-come, first-served).

Currently, the minimum stay is 1 month and the maximum 3 months – although this can be extended in certain cases.

All volunteers must be at least 25 years of age.
